

SAMPLE – JEWISH DAY EXCURSION

(Depends on time of docking and day of week)

- Disembark your ship and walk across to meet your guide and driver at the Plaza San Francisco
- As you head to your first Jewish stop, enjoy the drive down the most famous Cuban street –The Malecon. You will witness the change in architecture as you drive west from the oldest part of Havana to the newer neighborhood of Vedado.
- El Patronato – other otherwise known as Beth Shalom is the community center for Havana. It houses the donation supported pharmacy, has weekly Israeli dance group, senior group meetings Shabbat services, Sunday school and more.
- Centro Sefaradi is home to the Solomon Mitrani senior day center. Attached is the Holocaust Exhibition where you will learn about Cuba's connection to the Shoah.
- A drive by the Rosenberg memorial – yes to Ethal and Julius, traitors or Heros????!
- Next the Plaza de Revolucion to see the iconic Che silhouette.
- At Jewish Cemetery view some graves and stop by the oldest Holocaust Memorial in the Western Hemisphere housed at this place of rest.
- Continue to San Francisco de Paula where Ernest Hemingway built his home in Havana. It is now a museum as he left this home after his death to the Cuban people.
- A stop at Morro Castle to take in the amazing view of the city of Havana and a great place for a group photo
- And as time allows, as you end your day we can either take you back to the ship or drop you off at the Iconic Hotel Nacional where you can have a drink in the gardens, visit the cigar store and tour the Hall of Fame bar.
